

GREEN HILL COUNTRY CLUB ANNOUNCES

NEW SCHOLARSHIP FOR LOWER SHORE

Students from all three Maryland counties encouraged to apply

(March 17, 2006) --- The Green Hill Yacht & Country Club has established a new fund at the Community Foundation of the Eastern Shore that makes an annual \$1,000 scholarship available to students from Maryland's Lower Eastern Shore.

Students eligible to apply for the scholarship award must be past graduates or current graduating seniors of public or private high schools in Somerset, Wicomico or Worcester Counties who are pursuing a degree from an accredited college or university, or accredited two-year educational/vocational institution.

Applicants should have a satisfactory academic record that indicates they will be considered to be a good prospect to succeed academically at the college level. Scholastic honors, though desirable, are not a requirement, but applicants must be able to demonstrate that they are either conscientious employees or students.

Applicants will be required to write a 200 word essay explaining why they are applying for this scholarship and explaining their career and future education goals. Applicants may be required to be interviewed by a Scholarship Advisory Committee.

The deadline for submission of applications for the Green Hill Yacht & Country Club scholarship award is April 15th. For more information and a scholarship application form contact B.J.
